## Scholarship Guidelines Stroh Church of Christ Board Approved in 2016

- 1. Must be an active member of SCC.
- 2. Must attend a Christian Church/Church of Christ college.
- 3. Must fill out an application each semester and turn it into a minister.
- 4. Must be a full-time student at a Bible college (a minimum of 12 credit hours). A maximum of 4 years of undergraduate study.
- 5. Application includes:
  - a. Commitment to diligent preparation for service in the Kingdom.
  - b. Application approved by all the elders.
  - c. Submit a copy of each semester grades.
  - d. Phone # for the College or University Financial Aid Office.
  - e. One-page letter to the elders about your experience so far in college.
- 6. Fall semester scholarship applications are due no later than  $March 1^{st}$ , and spring semester applications are due no later than  $July 1^{st}$ .
- 7. For students pursuing a **Christian Ministry degree**, we will provide a
  - ♦ \$1,500 per semester scholarship if a grade point average at 2.5 or above is maintained per semester.
  - \$250 per 3.5 grade or higher on ministry and Bible classes.
- 8. If the major of study is a **non-ministry degree**, or changes to a **non-ministry degree**, we will provide a
  - \$500 per semester scholarship if a grade point average at 2.5 or above is maintained.
- 9. Students attending **Central Christian College of the Bible** will receive \$500 per semester (for GPA 2.5 or higher) for either degree because of the already established in house tuition scholarship. Ministry degree students can still earn extra for excellence in bible and ministry classes.
- 10. If you are studying to become a minister, it would be commendable to pay back part or all of this scholarship if you do not go into ministry.
- \* G.P.A. is based on a 4.0 grading scale
- \*\* Exceptions can be made in extenuating circumstances. Applications are handled on an individual basis.
